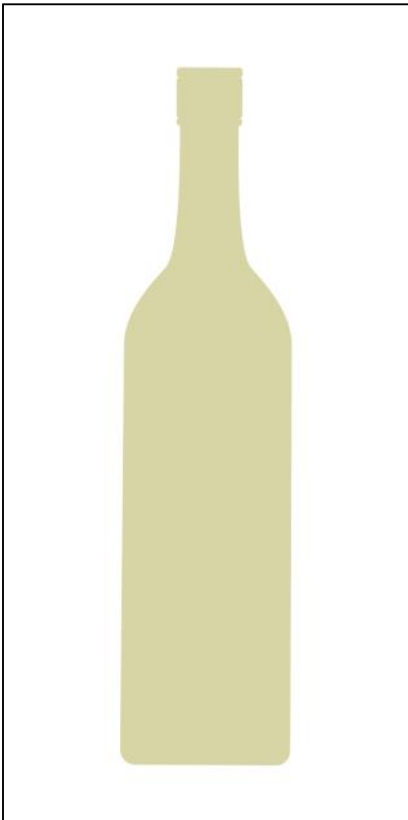




Prestige Charles Vintage Premier Cru Champagne 2005



The One Liner

Sweet and spiced vanilla combined with floral and toasty notes.

Tasting Notes

(70% Pinot Noir, 30% Chardonnay from 100% Cru rated vineyards.) Fine and complex with flowery aromas creating a good balance of freshness and roundness.

Awards & Press

Gardet was established in 1895 by Charles Gardet in Epernay. In the 1930s, his son, Georges Gardet, continued the family tradition by moving to Chigny-les-Roses to develop the Champagne Gardet brand. It was sold to the Prieux family in 2007. The Prieuxs have invested in the business, but wisely retained the features of the style of wine made over the years, only slightly refining it to be a little more forward-drinking with more fruit freshness and balance. The house owns around 7 ha of premier cru vineyards around their home villages of Chigny-Les-Roses, Ludes and Rilly la Montagne. The long tirage time and the use of a high proportion of reserve wine has marked the house style, and in fact is a distinguishing feature of Champagne Gardet.

Producer: Georges Gardet

Maison Gardet was established in 1896 by Charles Gardet in Chigny-les-Roses. In the 1930's his son, George, began his journey with Maison Gardet, developing the brand and continuing to create high quality wine. Today, the Prieux family have owned Maison Gardet since 2007. This family have brought the brand up-to-date but have very wisely retained the traditional processes that have produced quality and characterful Champagne year after year.
