



## Puy de Dome Pinot Noir Rose Cave St. VERNY 2017

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### The One Liner

Spicy cranberry and sweet white fruits.

### Tasting Notes

The nose is fresh with a little spicy cranberry but then overtaken by an array of almost sweet white fruits and melon. Rich in the mouth, with a blend of red and white fruits, like a fruit salad, superb ripeness and long-lasting flavours in the mouth. Ample with fresh and very sweet notes.

### Food Matches

Ideal with barbecues, charcuterie, pâtes, pizza, Mediterranean or exotic dishes. Its sweetness allows it to accompany fruit desserts.

### Producer: Cave Saint-Verny

The only wine co-operative in the Auvergne, Cave Saint-Verny, takes its name from Saint VERNY, who was adopted as the patron saint of vigneron in 1624 and whose image can still be seen throughout the Auvergne. The cellar takes in grapes from 53 communes throughout the area, resulting in an average holding of less than 2ha per member; a factor in understanding why more than half of the crop is still harvested by hand.
