




## Simonsig `Cape Fox` Chardonnay 2019

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### The One Liner

Full bodied with flavours of citrus and butterscotch.

### Tasting Notes

Elegantly wooded, this wine exhibits complex aromas of citrus and butterscotch. The palate is full bodied with a silky texture that tempts with layers of ripe apple, roasted almonds and toasty French oak ending in a long dry finish.

Ideal with most seafood e.g. Fresh wild oysters, Fish Carpaccio, Fish curry, Creamy crayfish pasta, shellfish salad.

Named after its dramatic views of the Simonsberg Mountain, the estate is situated in Stellenbosch, one of South Africa's premier wine regions, 45 km east of Cape Town. At the helm are the Malan family, descendants of the French Huguenot Jacques Malan who first arrived in the Cape in 1688, although it was the late Frans Malan who pioneered much of what the company stands for today. The Malan family are one of South Africa's most reputable wine producers. The three Malan brothers have passionate commitment towards quality and innovation. Simonsig wines are sold in more than 40 countries world-wide, including the United Kingdom, USA, Russia and Kenya.
